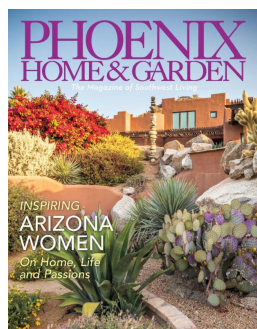

**PHOENIX HOME & GARDEN EDITOR'S LETTER**

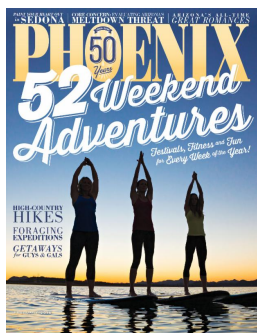

## SMALL SPACE SOLUTIONS

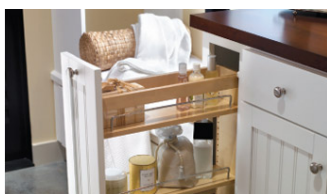
### SMALL SPACE STORAGE SOLUTIONS



Lifestyles are so complicated in our living spaces. How many clients do we have that want to simplify their spaces? So many want uncluttered spaces and don't know how to achieve them.

Corner swivel/pull-out units available for easy access instead of turning like a lazy suzan and having to reach in and under are really great for those with disabilities.



Organizing dishes, pots, pans, and lids can be challenging. Who wouldn't want their clients to have this type of drawer to have everything visibly accessible? Even a drawer within a drawer for placemats, napkins or silverware. Contact your kitchen, bath, closet, pantry showrooms you use and make sure to have them keep you current on these trending ideas to thrill your clients and get the most out of their spaces.
